
# I'LL TREE GNOME FOR CHRISTMAS







#### **Supplies Needed:**

- 1. Large marshmallows (2 or 3 per snowman)
- 2. Mini marshmallows (optional, for hats or buttons)
- 3. Pretzel sticks (for arms)
- 4. Toothpicks (for stacking)
- 5. Chocolate chips, mini candies, or edible markers (for faces and buttons)
- 6. Candy corn or orange sprinkles (for noses)
- 7. Icing or melted chocolate (for "gluing" pieces)
- 8. Small plates or napkins (for assembly)

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Cut the gnome door out on page 3 and place the letter in front
- 2. Use a toothpick to gently stack 2 or 3 large marshmallows on top of each other to form the snowman's body.
- 3. Carefully poke a pretzel stick into each side of the middle marshmallow to make arms.
- 4. Use chocolate chips, mini candies, or an edible marker to create eyes, a mouth, and buttons down the front.
- 5. Use a piece of candy corn, an orange sprinkle, or a small dab of orange icing for the snowman's nose.
- 6. Attach a mini marshmallow or candy to the top for a hat, or use a strip of licorice as a scarf. Use a little icing or melted chocolate to help pieces stick.
- 7. Display and Enjoy:
- 8. Place your finished snowman on a plate or napkin. Take a photo before eating or displaying!
